

Public School Application Process

1. There is no formal application process for entering public school. We will be part of the transition process from Wolf to public school. This will include attendance at meetings and hosting a visit for public school professionals at Wolf. Cheryl Johnson, Special Education Administrator, is the Wolf School contact person for public school placements.
2. Once you identify a school in your district, schedule an appointment with the school principal or guidance counselor to receive a general overview of the school who will talk to you about the school. This is your opportunity to ask about the size of classes, location of rooms, course opportunities, etc.
3. Contact the special education director to initiate the Individual Education Plan (IEP) process. You will need to find out who is the Team Chairperson for the school who will be directly responsible for the student's educational plan. We will assist you in this process by developing the appropriate goals and objectives and attending an initial meeting with the IEP team.
4. School specialists may request to administer updated evaluations in order to initiate an IEP.
5. If you are investigating a public school out of your district such as a collaborative or vocational school, ask about procedures for those placement options as well.
