

Admissions Process

1) Family completes an admissions inquiry available online at thewolfschool.org.

OR

1) Special Education Director sends a student referral packet.

2) After a MyWolf account is created within the Enrollment Management System, the family uploads recent evaluations which may include:

- Neuropsychological/Psychoeducational
- Speech and Language
- Occupational Therapy/Sensory Processing
- IEP (if applicable)

3) Director of Enrollment reviews evaluations.

4) Family uploads 1 minute, informal, Introductory Video of child.

5) Initial meeting(s) with Family or Special Education Director for a program overview, general intake, and tour of the school. Student may visit with the Director of Enrollment and tour the school with their family at that time, or at a later date.

6) If moving forward in the process, families are provided with an application, release form, and Developmental, Sensory, and Social Questionnaires on MyWolf.

7) Student's current teacher receives a "Current Teacher Checklist" through MyWolf. Families must input teacher email on MyWolf.

8) Director of Enrollment invites student to participate in an in-person classroom visit for up to three consecutive days.

9) Director of Enrollment meets with classroom team after student visit to review all information.

10) Family or Special Education Director is notified of decision.
