

Health & Safety Procedures for Families & Students

In an effort to protect the health and safety of our community, we ask that you please carefully read the following expected procedures. In accordance with recommendations from the CDC and the RIDOH, we ask that every student and family abide by these guidelines. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Anna Johnson. Thank you for your cooperation!

1. Please ensure that prior to coming for a tutoring session, your child is **not sick** and **does not have a temperature above 100.0°** or any other symptoms of COVID-19.

Your child will not be able to enter the building if anyone in your family has been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

2. Pick up and drop off for tutoring sessions will be in the **driveway at the front entrance**.
3. **Wait in your car** and until the teacher comes out to get your child.
4. Your child should **wear a mask** upon entering the building and until they enter their designated classroom.

Please note that to ensure the safety of our students, only one student will be using each classroom. That will be their assigned room for their time during the summer session.

5. Once your child enters the building, they will be instructed to **use hand sanitizer** and **their teacher will take their temperature** and sign them in.
6. Once the session is finished your child will **wash their hands or use hand sanitizer** and **put their masks back on** prior to leaving the classroom.
7. The teacher will then **sign your child out and walk them out of the building** to your car.
8. While outside, please **wear a mask when checking in with the teacher** at the end of your child's session.
