Admissions Process

1) Family contacts the Enrollment Team at (401) 432-9940 for preliminary information and completes an admissions inquiry available online at thewolfschool.org.

OR

- 1) Special Education Director contacts the Enrollment Team at (401) 432-9940 for preliminary information and sends a student referral packet.
- 2) Family or Special Education Director provides recent evaluations which may include:

Neuropsychological/Psychoeducational Speech and Language Occupational Therapy/Sensory Processing IEP (if applicable)

- 3) Director of Enrollment reviews evaluations.
- 4) Initial meeting with Family or Special Education Director for a program overview, general intake, and tour of the school.
- 5) Student visits with the Director of Enrollment and tours the school.
- 6) Families are provided with an application.
- 7) Student participates in a Wolf School Screener Day which includes screening sessions with Wolf staff, including a special educator, an Occupational Therapist, and a Speech Therapist.
- 8) Director of Enrollment meets with the screener team after screener day to review all information.
- 9) Director of Enrollment notifies Family or Special Education Director of decision.

OR

- 9) Director of Enrollment invites student to participate in an individualized in person classroom visit for at least 3 consecutive days.
- 10) Director of Enrollment meets with classroom team after student visit to review all information.
- 11) Director of Enrollment notifies Family or Special Education Director of decision.
